

 Emergency content updates only




## Past Solutions . . .



Drupal 7 and Drupal 8 - 8.4

Allowed for individual page publishing, block publishing, and files.

Had environment selection





## Other Solutions . . .

#### **CMS Content Sync**

Allowed for individual entity publishing and files

Service Charges

3rd party environment for file transfer

### Acquia Content Hub

Did not allow for true stage and production environments

# Writing Directly to Production server

User errors

Security Concern

### Database copy

Does not allow for individual page publishing

Requires engineer




# Content Synchronization . . .

Our solution leverages the existing module Content Synchronization

Exports entities to YML files

Exports related content YML files (entity reference, menu, user, etc)





## Our Solution . . .

Leverages Content Synchronization module...

Compiles YML files and carries across environments through SSH

Has "timed" deployment, dependent on CRON

### **Requirements:**

• SSH access to environments

### In Progress:

- Files
- Path Auto



## Set Up...


Create API Key Folder (with proper keys) and deploy content folder at root level on all environments


**Enable Module**

Set up permissions



	Environment URL
is	the url of the Stage site and if anything given in this field then below SSH details will be considered required. Example: https://example.com
	SSH Details
	User Name
	This is the SSH user name of the stage site.
	Host
	This is the SSH host of the stage site.
ć	Authentication Type
	Key V
	This is the method with which SSH connection will be authenticated.
	Public Key Path
	Add the SSH public key path here. Please use the server path here and this path should be of Current server. Example : /mydir/.ssh/id_rsa.pub
	Private Key Path
	Add the SSH private key path here. Please use the server path here and this path should be of Current server. Example : /mydir/.ssh/id_rsa
	Port
	roit
	Port to maintain SSH connection. If left empty, default port 22 will be considered.
	Auto-deploy directory path


